Agnes is currently leading research projects investigating learning innovation in the UK and internationally. She has led numerous projects investigating innovative and emergent practice with learning

technologies in post-16 education. Agnes has recently been part of the European MOTILL project on mobile technologies in lifelong learning and the MASELTOV project on smart and personalized technologies for social inclusion of immigrants and the British Council project on Mobile Pedagogy for English Language Teaching. She has a long standing research interest in effective communication with technology and the experiences of non-technical users.
